Rascally Red Panda Encounter

Encounter Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Rascally Red Panda Animal Encounters are available to Participants who are 6 years of age and above only.
2. Children 6 -14yrs MUST be accompanied to the encounter by a paying, participating adult.
3. Suitable footwear must be worn during the encounter i.e. no high heels.
4. Participants must be able to remain in a seated position for the duration of the encounter (15-20 minutes), and be capable of manoeuvring across uneven ground.

Generic Terms and Conditions

1. All Participants, including children, must follow all instructions given by the handlers. Each Participant must be able to understand English or have a paying, participating interpreter with them.
2. Australia Zoo reserves the right to refuse any person to participate in the Animal Encounter for health, safety or other reasons. Participants may be asked to cease the encounter at any time for whatever reason at the handler's discretion.
3. Some encounters may require special assistance to provide access to Wheelchair bound guests. Staff must be informed of mobility issues when booking the encounter.
4. Animal Encounters are subject to weather. Please be aware that the encounter may need to be cancelled if bad weather occurs before or during the session. The encounter will be rescheduled for the next available date, at the Zoo's discretion.
5. All encounters are subject to change without notice. If the encounter is cancelled by Australia Zoo, you will have the option to receive a full refund or reschedule to another encounter time or day.
6. Cancellation within 48hrs of the Session shall result in forfeiture of the prize.
7. No personal items or food are permitted on the encounter, this includes camera's and backpacks. In some circumstances, a phone or small camera will be allowed.
8. Please remember that all animals are capable of exercising their natural instincts. Do not under any circumstances attempt to roughly handle the animal. Contact with animals will be under the handler's direction - please do not touch animal's head, face or any other body parts unless directed to by the animal handler.
9. All interaction will be instigated by the animals. The behaviour of the animals or the outcome/level of interaction is not guaranteed under any circumstances.
10. Australia Zoo does not take any responsibility for any injuries, howsoever received whether it be as a result of the Animal Encounter, travelling to, or being in, the enclosure in which the animal is housed.
11. The food we feed to our animals may contain nuts, eggs, fruit, seafood, raw meat and other food products. Please ensure any allergies are discussed with staff prior to the encounter being undertaken.
12. Participants must be aware that they may be filmed during experiences for media purposes.
13. The Participant consents to the publication and/or use in any media whatsoever of their name, image, voice statements or otherwise, without payment of compensation.
